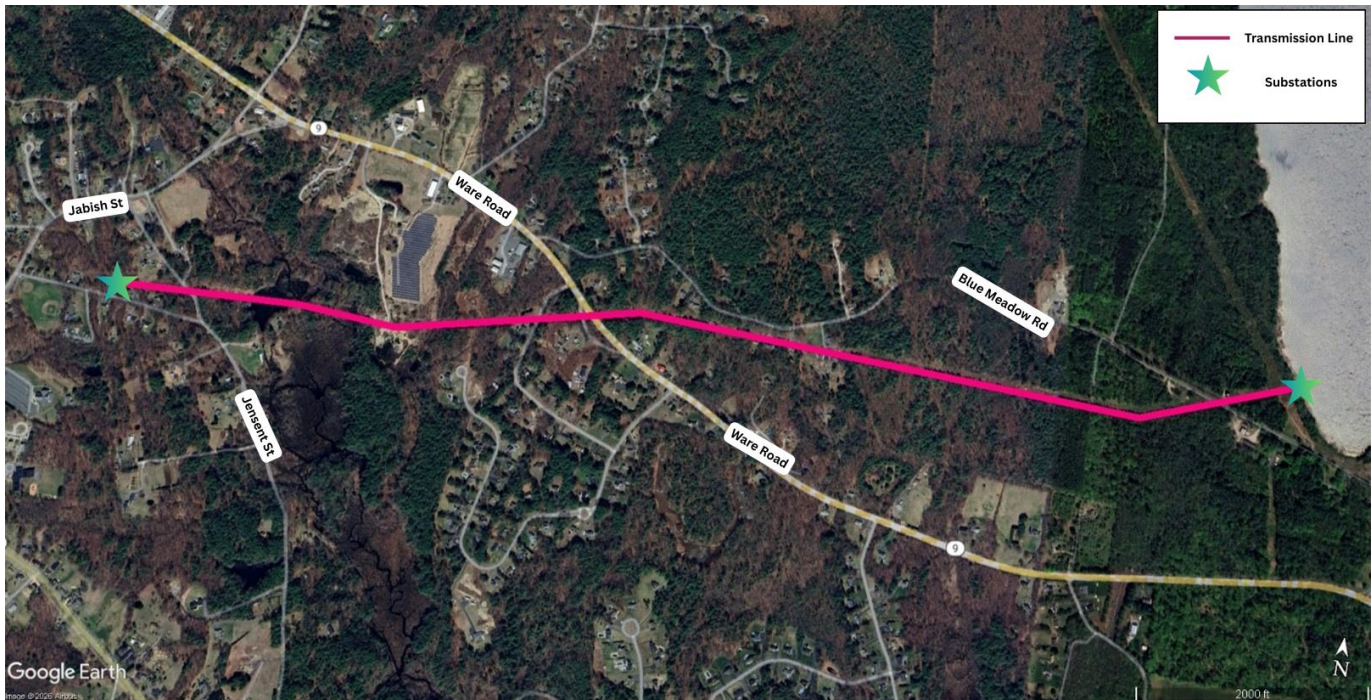
Project Overview

The Belchertown Reliability Project will upgrade National Grid's B69 transmission line in Belchertown. The line was originally built in 1997 and needs to be modernized to maintain reliability.

The B69 line runs roughly 2 miles between the Quabbin Tower Substation (near Jensen Street) and the Quabbin Switching Station (off Blue Meadow Rd).

During construction, most work areas will be within National Grid's and the public right of way. These areas will be accessed from public roads, existing easements, or other access routes.

What to expect during construction:

- Increased activity along the Right of Way.
- Vegetation management (tree removal and trimming).
- Matting installation in some areas.
- Pole installation.
- No interruption to service for National Grid customers.
- Restoration of disturbed areas.
