Hanover, MA | Spring 2026

National Grid is planning work to replace aging electrical equipment within the Water Street Substation with new equipment. The project will increase electric reliability in the area.

The project is currently in its design phase, with the project team performing field investigations to use in project engineering. As the project moves toward the construction phase, neighbors will receive more updates.

Project details:

The Water Street Substation Upgrade project includes the replacement and enhancement of existing equipment within National Grid's substation. The project will improve electrical reliability in the region, ensuring enhanced service and operational efficiency.

What to expect during construction:

- **Residents can anticipate increased activity** within the substation area. This includes increased personnel presence, equipment utilization, and material deliveries going in and out of the substation.
- **Restoration** of any disturbed roadway/sidewalk areas.
