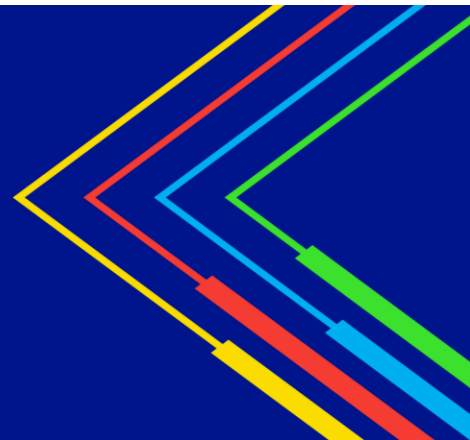

Upcoming Activities

Dear Neighbor,

Over the next several months, National Grid and its contractors will be working within the right-of-way near your home or business.

Starting soon contractors for National Grid will be conducting environmental survey work in and around the existing transmission right-of-way in your area. The data collected will be utilized during the engineering phase of upcoming needed structure replacements.

The Public Archaeology Laboratory, Inc. (PAL) is National Grid's authorized cultural resource / archaeology contractor and will conduct the survey work throughout the existing right-of-way.

PAL field survey crews will use existing access roads and points throughout and adjacent to the power line corridor. Crews will have identification and further information about this work. As they conduct the survey work, you may see flagging, GPS work, and targeted areas for soil evaluation. PAL survey crews may dig small shovel test pits (measuring 2 ½ feet square to a depth of approximate 3 feet deep) to analyze soils within the right-of-way, and will backfill the area when completed. Work will occur for several days at each site.
